The PEER Consortium articulates Tech Prep Career Pathways or programs of study that begin in high school and continue through an associate or baccalaureate degree, a journeyworker's license, a postsecondary-level industry certification, or state licensure. Features include college credit earned during high school through dual enrollment courses and/or industry-recognized certifications and assessments, early college placement testing, work-based learning experience, career coaching, and more.
