Application Deadlines and Registration Fees:

Applications that are postmarked by December 31, 2007 qualify for a discounted registration fee of \$50.00. After December 31, 2007 the registration fee will be \$75.00.

All applications must be postmarked by March 2, 2008 and accompanied by photos of recent, original and handmade work. (Artists who participated in the 2006 or 2007 Fool for Art Festival do not need to resubmit photos.)

Screening will take place throughout the application period, and notice of acceptance letters will be mailed on an ongoing basis. Registration fees are due upon acceptance. Please do not mail checks with application.

Space: A 10 x 10 area will be provided. Approved applicants are responsible for providing their own tents, canopies, displays, tables or any other equipment needed. Electricity will not be available.

An event program will be provided, and the event will be advertised to the greater Richmond area through www.jtcc.edu and media outlets such as NBC 12, Lite 98, *Style Weekly*, *The Richmond Times-Dispatch* and *Chesterfield Observer*.
