- Students are strongly encouraged to complete their SDV, ENG, and MTH requirements first.
- The history elective requirement can be satisfied by the following courses: HIS 101, HIS 102, HIS 111, HIS 112, HIS 121, HIS 122 or any other HIS course approved by the student's advisor.
- The laboratory science requirement can be satisfied by the following courses: BIO 101, BIO 102, BIO 110, BIO 120, CHM 101, CHM 102, CHM 111, CHM 112, ENV 121, ENV 122, GOL 105, NAS 125, PHY 101, PHY 102, PHY 150, PHY 201, PHY 202, PHY 241, and PHY 242. Students seeking transfer to VCU to major in Psychology should take BIO 101 and BIO 102.

- The literature requirement can be satisfied by any 200-level English literature course, exclusive of composition and creative writing courses.
