NOTES:

1. Students are strongly encouraged to complete their SDV, ENG, and MTH requirements first.
2. Students should consult with their academic advisor and check with prospective four-year institutions to determine best options for transfer.
3. Students who completed three years of the same foreign language in high school have met the foreign language requirement and must take two courses from the Approved Electives list instead of SPA or French 101-102. Heritage or conversationally fluent Spanish speakers may enroll directly into SPA or FRE 102. Please check with your advisor to determine the best option(s) for course substitution or if you wish to take a foreign language other than Spanish or French.
4. Students taking ECO 201 may also be required to take ECO 202. See your academic advisor.
5. Transfer institutions may have computer competency or health/physical education requirements. Students must consult with their academic advisor to determine the best options for transfer.
6. Students should regularly meet with their faculty advisor, confirm requirements at desired four-year institution, and check their advisement report in MyTyler – SIS.
