- Students are eligible to apply to the nursing program while enrolled in or after completion of the first semester prerequisites courses.
- A student must have completed BIO 141 within 10 years prior to acceptance into the Nursing Program.
- BIO 150 must be taken concurrently or prior to the second semester and ENG 112 or HLT 230 must be taken concurrently or prior to the third semester.
- Students planning to transfer to VCU should take HLT 230.
- The Humanities Elective must be taken prior to or during the fourth semester.
- The nursing courses are sequential and must be taken in the semester listed.
- NSG 100 and NSG 106 are co-requisite courses and must be taken concurrently.
- Withdrawal from NSG 200 requires withdrawal from NSG 100 and NSG 106
- Withdrawal from NSG 100 and NSG 106 does not require withdrawal from NSG 200
